












HIKING & MOUNTAIN BIKING TRAILS

BRIDLE CREEK RIPARIAN HABITAT

Bridle Creek is a 31-acre fenced riparian habitat located behind the Community Campus at the base of Sanders Mesa. The area primarily is composed of cottonwood and willow trees surrounding desert landscaping. There is a collection of birds and other wildlife in the vicinity.
