BRIDLE CREEK RIPARIAN HABITAT

Bridle Creek is a 31-acre fenced riparian habitat located behind the Community Campus at the base of Sanders Mesa. The area primarily is composed of cottonwood and willow trees surrounding desert landscaping. There is a collection of birds and other wildlife in the vicinity. Four-wheel drive may be required on some of these roads. Bruce Mine road is accessible from town and turns into a dirt road that goes past the Kellis' Ranch and is a local favorite for walking, jogging and driving off-road vehicles.

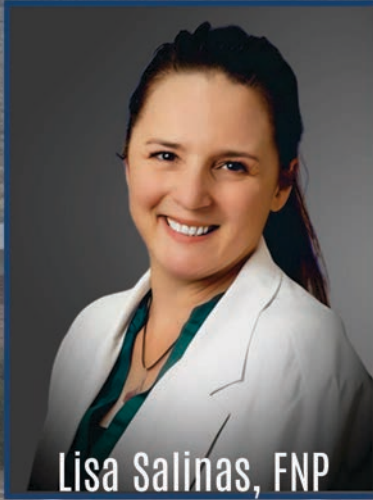

Nestled in the picturesque Sonoran Desert of central Arizona, Bagdad is a vibrant community deeply intertwined with the legacy of its iconic Bagdad Mine. Established in 1882, the Bagdad Mine has been a cornerstone of the town's economy, producing copper continuously for over a century. With an annual production capacity of 146 million pounds of copper, and 10 million pounds of molybdenum, the mine is one of the largest in the United States, employing hundreds of local residents and contributing significantly to the region's prosperity.

Beyond its industrial significance, Bagdad offers a unique blend of desert charm and community warmth.
