


LOCAL TRAILS AND HIKES

BRIDLE CREEK

This area offers a short easy hike.

BRIDLE CREEK RIPARIAN HABITAT

Bridle Creek is a 31-acre fenced riparian habitat located behind the Community Campus at the base of Sanders Mesa. The area primarily is composed of cottonwood and willow trees surrounding desert landscaping. There is a collection of birds and other wildlife in the vicinity. There are two different parking lots and three different entrances into the creek. For more information, go to:

"B" MOUNTAIN

This is a short, steep and rocky trail that rewards with fantastic views of Bagdad, the mine and the surrounding mountains. The trail is accessed at the corner of Mesa Drive and Randall in Bagdad. As you enter Bagdad on Main Street, turn right on Fletcher, then left on Randall. At the corner of Randall and Mesa is a dirt road to the left that travels 150 yards to a locked gate. Cars may park on the side of the dirt road before the gate.

Use: Hiking only Distance: 1.2 Miles Type: Out and back

Trailhead: lat/lng (34.57868, -113.18383)

Route: The two-track road begins at a locked gate. The gate must be scaled to access the trail. The trail climbs gently for 200 yards and then makes a hard right where it begins to climb steeply for 0.4 miles where it levels off, offering views of Bagdad. The trail ends at an opening in the fence that continues toward the airport which is not open to the public.



BRUCE MINE ROAD

This road turns into a dirt road that goes past the Kellis' Ranch and is a local favorite for walking, jogging and driving off-road vehicles.

OUTDOOR RECREATION SPOTS

There are a number of outdoor recreation opportunities in the area, including the Santa Maria River, Lions Campground, Wild Horse Ranch and Black Pearl. Four-wheel drive may be required on some of these roads. Please contact Community Services for maps and / or information on how to get there.





SANTA MARIA POOLS

During the dry season, this portion of the Santa Maria River is left with water pools great for splashing around to cool off or lounging by the sandy shore.

Use:

Hike, Bike, Horse and ATV (4x4 within 1/4 mile to pools)

Distance: 2.2 Miles

Type: Out and back

Trailhead:

lat/lng (34.48208,-113.06033)

The trailhead is accessed from State Route 96 just northwest of the Santa Maria River Bridge at approximately milepost 11. Park road vehicles just north of the bridge on the east side in the dirt lot.

Route:

The two-track recreation road leading to the pools runs on the north side of the Santa Maria River. Travel to the right when you encounter the two "Y" style intersections along the way. At three points you will be required to navigate usually dry, yet steep, washes. The last is unpassable by 4x4 passenger vehicle, but only about a quarter mile from the pools.

Total Elevation Gain: 128 feet

Scholarships



BAGDAD UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

BUSD Consists of an Elementary School, Junior High and High School all located on one campus. BUSD also offers Special Needs Preschool to community members.

Bagdad Middle School

High School Elective Classes

Bagdad has initiated elective classes that support math education under the headings of Engineering, Career and Technical, and Aviation. The aviation class culminating activity is an actual flight from the Bagdad Airport.
