SANTA MARIA POOLS

During the dry season, this portion of the Santa Maria River is left with water pools great for splashing around to cool off or lounging by the sandy shore.

Use: Hike, Bike, Horse and ATV $(4x4 \text{ within } \frac{1}{4} \text{ mile to pools})$

Distance: 2.2 Miles Type: Out and back

Trailhead:

lat/lng (34.48208,-113.06033)

The trailhead is accessed from State Route 96 just northwest of the Santa Maria River Bridge at approximately milepost 11. Park road vehicles just north of the bridge on the east side in the dirt lot.

Route: The two-track recreation road leading to the pools runs on the north side of the Santa Maria River. Travel to the right when you encounter the two intersections along the way. At three points you will be required to navigate usually dry, yet steep, washes. The last is unpassable by 4x4 passenger vehicle, but only about a quarter mile from the pools.

Total Elevation Gain: 128 feet


This area offers a short easy hike.










AQUATIC CENTER






- PHYSICAL THERAPY -


Scholarships
